
Dear masters hockey friends,

We have been preparing everything necessary for the Masters World Cup 2020 Tokyo.

As to the traffic service in Tokyo, we have established our basic policy as below. As you might be aware, Tokyo is one of the most populated cities in the world. Traffic system is pretty much huge, complicated but well organized.

We are glad to serve you with various information concerning the traffic in Tokyo upon your request.

First of all. please refer to our Basic Policy and Guideline of Transportation in Tokyo.



HNOC Basic Policy of Transportation in Tokyo

In principal, we would like to recommend using public transportation to be used for traffic between hotel and venues.

This will be helpful to save your travel cost and also preserve clean air to certain extent.





HNOC will not provide shuttle bus service since it is not practical in terms of economy and convenience because of scattered locations of hotels.











Guideline for Transportation in Tokyo

The best transportation route between your hotel, Oi Hockey Stadium, and Komazawa Stadium is depending on the location of your hotel.

We are ready to suggest the best way of transportation, approximate time required and its fare upon request.



We can introduce charter bus company for your transportation between your hotel and the venue. Terms and condition should be negotiated by the team.



HNOC will not organize sightseeing bus tour, but can provide information of bus companies and interpreter/tour guides in almost every language upon request.



We will inform you of estimated Taxi fare for certain distance upon request. It is recommended to use one Taxi car by three passengers.



Tokyo is one of the biggest cities in the world having population of more than 14 million.

Its traffic system and condition is complicated and having variety of choices. Our Hotel Recommendation List shows the hotels near the Oi Hockey Stadium but we suggest you to study way of transportation well in advance. Komazawa Venue is a bit far from the hotel area and may necessary to change trains / buses a few times depending on the hotel location.

It is suggested to study the best way and necessary time well in advance.

Access infomation for Public transportation from the Hotel to the Venue shall be provided through Q&A Section in the Website on demand.

It is strongly suggested to purchase and use IC Cards for your public transportation.

> IC cards are prepaid e-money cards that can be used to pay the fare for trains and buses.

> There are major IC cards, including Suica that are interchangeably usable in most major cities in

> They can also be used for making purchases at many shops and restaurants across Japan.

> IC cards are rechargeable cards that can be used to conveniently pay fares on public transportation and to make payments at many vending machines, shops and restaurants by simply touching the card on a reader.

Suica is the most recommendable IC Card.

Suica is a prepaid IC card by JR East for JR trains in the Greater Tokyo.

You can buy this card at its ticket office or ticket vending machine of all JR railway stations





The special cards are valid for only four weeks, come without a deposit fee. but do not allow for refunds.

You can buy Welcome Suica card at six major railway stations of Tokyo, Shinjuku, Shibuya, Ikebukuro, Ueno and Hamamatsucho where is the terminal station of the Tokyo Monorail line.

Oi Hockey Stadium is located between Hamamatsucho and Haneda Airport stations of this line.

Haneda and Narita airport rail stations sell also Welcome Suica.

Look for the sign of "JR EAST Travel Service" at each station, then you can buy Welcome Suica with credit cards or cash.

Important Notice for Change of Hotel Booking Procedures

Please be advised of the following for your Hotel Booking Procedures.

- It was planned to open a Website for Hotel Booking by JTB, our official Travel agency and announced to you accordingly through our News Letters.
- Recently it has been discovered that such Website established by JTB is not convenient for our use. JTB' s Website was originally designed for individual travelers, not for group travelers.
- As our conclusion, it has been decided not to use this Website for Hotel Booking Procedures for your teams.

Hotel Booking shall be arranged as follows.

He will receive your inquires, manage all booking procedures and liaise between you and JTB. Official booking shall be contracted between you and JTB. HNOC is not a contract party.

- · Arrival date and Departure date
- Number of required rooms per Single, Twin and Double.
- Budget of the room charge in Japanese Yen per person including breakfast, service charge and tax.

5 Basic Terms and Conditions :

- It is requested to fix required number of rooms by the end of May, 2020 and 25% deposit shall be paid accordingly.
- It is free to change number of rooms without any charge until 61 days prior to your arrival date, even after your final payment.
- Final payment shall be made 3 months prior to the arrival date.
- Cancel Policy 50% cancellation charge for cancellation being made $60 \sim 31$ days prior to the arrival date.

100% cancellation charge for cancellation being made $30 \sim 0$ days prior to the arrival date.
